Baha'i Influence in the Pharmaceutical Market

According to a well-informed source, a number of Baha'i Zionist activists have recently purchased a number of pharmacies in Tehran through a calculated programme, which has raised concerns in religious circles. One of the officials in charge of the location of the pharmacies bought by these people in the last few months announced that they are mostly in the northern regions of Tehran.
